## General Spares; the following items may be useful for simple running repairs.

**Vehicle specific spares;** are generally specific to your vehicle or a vehicle of the same type. Consider items on this list for longer and / or more difficult trips where outside assistance is not available. Wherever possible these spares should try to be shared with like vehicles.

**Tools** are many and varied. What you carry is heavily dependent on the type of trip and what can be shared amongst vehicles on the trip. Below is a list of tools to be considered.
